Sales

Every effort will be made to encourage sales. The Tewksbury Historical Society will retain a 30% commission on the sale of any and all juried works, Small Works and Portfolio Showcase pieces. Sale prices may not be changed after entries have been submitted. Payment to artists may take up to 30 – 45 days. **All juried artwork must remain on premises for the duration of the exhibition.**

A Short History

Established by the Historical Society in 1989 to preserve Tewksbury through artwork exclusively depicting Tewksbury Township subjects, the "Tewksbury Art Show has expanded its scope while retaining its original spirit. The show encompasses juried, small works and portfolio Areas..

Jurors

Judge of Selection: Oscar Peterson

Oscar is an alumnus of Pratt Institute and the Art Students League and has studied with outstanding realist painters such as Nelson Shanks, Dave Passalacqua and Costa Vavagiakis. He is a multi-award winning artist (Arts Students League, SOHO Painting Competition, Morristown Community Theater, MSHAC Juried Show at the Paper Mill Theatre Gallery) specializing in portraiture. He is a instructor of drawing and painting at the Center for Contemporary Art, the Hunterdon Art Museum and the Farmstead Arts Center.

Oscar works in many media preferring oils for his commissioned work. His approach is to "capture the grace and beauty of ordinary people".

He has exhibited his work in many venues from the Tell Two, 10 Year Retrospective, Millburn Library, Montclair Gallery, Grant winners Exhibition at the Art Students League to the GE Corporate Headquarters Black History Month Exhibition in Fairfield, Connecticut.

Oscar who was born in Harlem and raised in Brooklyn now lives in Millburn, New Jersey.

Judge of Awards: Dannielle Mick

Dannielle Mick creates works of art in all mediums. Her art is inspired by the natural world, featuring sea, sky, and landscapes. She likes to maintain a sense of simplicity and finds beauty in every day surroundings.

She is both artist and art educator at her Lakeside Art Studio and has been teaching for over 30 years. Dannielle has studied at the Art Institute of Chicago, the New School of Parsons, NYC, the National Academy of Fine Art, The Art Students League among others and with artists Richard McKinley, Bend, OR, Jenny Nelson, Woodstock, NY and Wolf Kahn, PSA, NY. She is an award winning artist with a multitude of honors such as the Salmagundi Club, NY, Conn. Pastel Society, Allied Artists, Audubon Society, Catherine Lorillard Wolfe Arts club, etc. Exhibitions include such far flung places as Uzbekistan and Taiwan to Yarmouth MA, Kimnberly, WI, Provincetown, Morristown, Bay Head, NJ, etc. She has been featured in numerous publications from Jersey Shore Magazine to The New York Times.

She is a past President of the Pastel Society of New Jersey and a past Board of Directors member of the Audubon Artists, Inc., NY. She resides in Parsippany New Jersey.

Eligibility of Juried Work

- Artists must be a minimum of 18 years old
- Each artist may submit up to 5 works to be juried
- No work may exceed 40" in any direction – **only one 40" submission per artist**
- Paintings on stretched canvas may be presented framed or unframed, and wired – ready to hang
- Painting on canvas board must be framed and wired-ready to hang
- Works on paper including photography must be matted, framed, glazed with glass or Plexiglas

Eligibility of Juried Work contd.

Artists are encouraged to submit work to the "Small Works" area as well as the "Portfolio Showcase". **These works must be pre-registered in their respective Entrythingy calls.** (There is No charge for entering the Small Works and Portfolio calls and they are not juried, but you must enter the juried call (\$30) to enter Small Works and Portfolio shows.) **The three parts of the show are in three separate calls on Entrythingy.**

ALL artwork must be labeled for sale.

Juried Work Media

Must be original artwork **not previously submitted to this show!**

Works completed in any 2 dimensional media (including photography) may be submitted.

No giclees allowed.

Small Works and Portfolio Procedures

Data to be affixed to the front of the work:

Artist Name, Price and Title of Work

Eligibility of "Small Works"

(Open only to artists entering the Juried call)

- Up to 5 pieces may be submitted
- **Frame** measurements no larger than 14" x 18"
- Each artist may submit up to 5 pieces (Properly framed, glazed & **wired-no saw-tooth hangers**)
- Marked for sale: Mark price, artist name, title of piece on the front of work (not on gilded frames)
- Small Works must be brought in an appropriately sized sturdy box labeled with the artist's name
- Prices of "Small Works" may not exceed \$250.

Eligibility of "Portfolio Showcase"

(Open only to artists entering the Juried call)

- Up to 10 portfolio pieces may be brought
- Artist must supply a professional **floor standing-print rack** for the pieces
- Portfolio pieces may not exceed the outside dimensions of the portfolio
- Each piece must be professionally presented and labeled as required above

Liability Clause

Entries and artwork will be handled with all possible care. However, the Tewksbury Historical Society and the Zion Lutheran Church will NOT be responsible for any loss or damage that might occur. We advise you to insure your own artwork.

Pay Entry Fee via Paypal (you may use a major credit card – you don't need a Paypal account)
One entry fee of \$30.00 covers all 3 submissions!
- Go to Entrythingy Juried Show call - complete entry requirements and upload juried entry photos (in jpeg format)**
- Go to Entrythingy Small Works Show call (if entering)**
Complete entry requirements (Title, Dimensions, Price only)
upload and submit (no image required).
- Go to Entrythingy Portfolio Show call (If entering)**
Complete entry requirements (Title, Dimensions, Price only)
upload and submit (no image required).
- Watch for [email](#) of declined work by 9/24 (if you do not receive any email all your submitted works are accepted)**
Bring accepted Juried work, Small Works, Portfolio, in on 10/3 or 10/4 (see Prospectus)
